

FREE TRANSLATION OF A LETTER, DATED 4th August 1926, to the  
GENOA OFFICE FROM THE FIAT MOTOR CO.

"LA PLAYA"  
Fiat Type Q-504 Motors.

It is our intention to request the Classification of  
Lloyd's Register for the new motors which we have to construct  
in lieu of those already fitted on this vessel.

The ship is already classed in Lloyd's Register and  
our contract comprises only the fitting of the new motors in  
place of the old ones. The general arrangement of the  
electric generators and motors, the line of shafting, the  
auxiliaries and the fittings generally (including fly wheel, air  
bottles, silencers and all piping) will remain unchanged and all  
these parts have already been surveyed by you.

In these circumstances we feel that as has been  
done in similar cases by other Classification Societies, we  
ought to obtain some reduction in the fee, particularly as we  
have in addition the expense of the British Corporation Survey.

We would appreciate an early reply pending which  
we have retained your survey request form.

We attach a list showing the principle characteristics  
of the motors.
