I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant, the contents of which have been noted.

Provided the ship is generally examined by the Society's Surveyors, and found or placed in satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage, the desired certificate may be issued.

I would point out, however, that the certificate will indicate that the class of the ship is temporarily suspended during the voyage, that it relates only to the fitness of the hull to be towed, and that the towage arrangements are the responsibility of the Owners.

If steam is required for towage purposes, then it will be necessary for at least one boiler to be examined.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Society's Office at Piraeus, and the Surveyors there should be requested to attend by your local Agents, when the ship is ready for their inspection.
