With reference to your letter of yesterday respecting the S.S. "EMBLETON", this vessel was actually under survey at the time of our Return dated 27th August, ~~when~~ the freeboard was verified, ^{and} it was expected that the equipment would have been dealt with. However, Wilson & Burlinson were unable at that time to get the anchors on board and we closed our entry in the Surveys Book with a letter which Mr. Macdonald wrote to London also on the 27th August. Our report on the equipment went forward yesterday and has no doubt reached your hands before this.
