This ship was under survey at Kobe in September for Docking and advancement of the Machinery Continuous Survey.

The ballast pump water end was found to be corroded, and it is recommended that it be re-examined before the end of September, 1959. The Committee have continued the class subject to this receiving attention by that time.

The Donkey Boilers were also examined at this time and records of Docking Survey 9.58 and Donkey Boiler Survey 9.58 have now been assigned.
