I enclose herewith First Entry Report on above vessel, also copy of Interim Certificate issued, from which certificate you will note that a subject condition has been placed on the class of the vessel on account of the steering chains now fitted. The test certificate which accompanied these chains is not satisfactory and from this document it would appear that the chains have not been tested in accordance with Rule Requirements, also that the weight per 15 fathom length is under that shown for 7/16" dia. short link chain cable in the Rules.

The Builders state that this matter will be dealt with in Calcutta, to which Port the vessel is now proceeding, and a copy of this letter has been forwarded to the Calcutta Surveyors for their information.
