The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

This ship is over 38 years old.

There is an Endorsement of C class (B).

A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 12,54.

In reply to various queries concerning the Special Survey the Piraeus Surveyor stated that the ship remained laid up.

The class of the ship was qualified with the Notation of "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue" by the Committee 31.8.54.

The PIRAEUS Surveyor reports (3,56), ship examined afloat and the Special Survey due 12,54 commenced by the examination of the upper deck plating.

As a result of the Surveyor's recommendation for a considerable number of deck plates to be renewed, the Owners cancelled the Special Survey and have withdrawn the ship from the Society's class.

In view of the above the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
