We have to advise you that Island Tug & Barge Ltd. have informed us that they have purchased the above mentioned three tankers which are to be towed from Maracaibo to Victoria, B.C.

The new Owners have not decided yet for what purpose the vessels will be used in future and they may be converted as barges as the same Owners propose with the Tankers "CARLOTA", "CHEPITA" and "CONCHITA" and "ICOTEA", recently purchased and now at Victoria.

It is noted these vessels have the notation 'Laid Up - Survey Overdue' and it would be appreciated if you would kindly advise further particulars of any special requirements in case the new Owners may decide to retain Classification.

Island Tug & Barge Lt. have also requested to be supplied with copies of the original approved Hull Structural Drawings and Bilge and Cargo Pumping Arrangements of one of these three sister ships. Drawings of Machinery and Rudder will not be required at this stage.
