With reference to your letter of the 16th ultimo relative to the steamer "PETERSTON", Messrs. Bartram & Sons' No. 258, we wish to inform you that she is leaving here tomorrow for your port for completion.

In order to entitle the vessel to the record of LMC on completion, the following requires to be done.

- (1). Donkey Boiler to efficiently secure in position.
- (2). Pipes etc, to same to connect.
- (3). Safety valves to adjust under steam.
- (4). Easing gear to fit.

Our report No. 12188 on the Donkey Boiler is forwarded herewith for completion.

It is stated that the Electric Light Installation will be completed at your port.
