Steamer "GENERAL SAN MARTIN"

The Committee have today had before them the case of the above named ship together with your letter of the 20th instant, and they are obliged to you for your comments.

They appreciate that the Owners' present proposal may not be fulfilled, but feel they must treat this case on the same basis as other similar instances. Accordingly they feel that some final warning must be made to the Owners and desire them to be informed that if, for any reason, the vessel is not placed in dry-dock for survey before 20th November next they will have no alternative but to deal with the class.

As a Special Survey fell due last June, this inspection must be held in conjunction with the dry-docking or at least a General Examination carried out with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey.
