Nature of Survey

This vessel, which was surveyed for classification at Southampton in October 1921, was classed 100 A1 and notation of SS. Cws. No. 1.21 was assigned.

The Owners now desire that the above notation might be amended to a notation of SS. No. 3 and the Southampton Surveyors state, in reply to enquiry, they are of the opinion that the Survey carried out by them would entitle the vessel to the notation desired by the Owners.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed and to have the Notation SS. No. 1.21 amended to SS. Cws. No. 3-10.21.

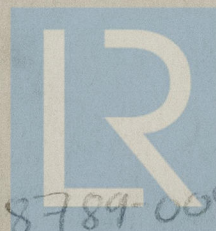
