Steamers "CONSUELO" & "JURANDY"

With reference to your letter of the 8th ultimo, I have to inform you that we have been unable to obtain confirmation that these ships have actually been classed by the Bureau Veritas.

So far as the "JURANDY" is concerned, the present record of class suspension will stand in the Register Book in the meantime, but I shall be glad if you will inform me of any future developments.

The position in regard to the "CONSUELO" is not clear, and I shall be glad to learn whether this ship is still laid up, as if it is trading it may be necessary to take further action in regard to the class.
