GENERAL REMARKS


Messrs. Mechans Ltd., Glasgow attend at their Works on the 23rd. February, 1927 and subsequently for the purpose of examining during construction two riveted steel compressed Air Receivers intended for Messrs. George Brown & Co's M.V. No.155.

The receivers have been built under special survey in accordance with the approved plan and the material for the same has been tested in accordance with the rules of this Society.

On completion the receivers were tested in the presence of the undersigned by hydraulic pressure to 500 lbs. per square inch, shewed no signs of weakness and were found tight and sound in every respect. Working pressure not to exceed 300 lbs. per square inch.
