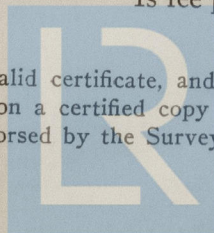
"The Certificate has been endorsed in accordance with the Regulations of the Department of Commerce and extended until the 1st March, 1939."
