
Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that application forms, Req. 9(N), for the assignment of International Convention freeboards have been received from Messrs. Gørrissen & Co., of Oslo, the Owners of the following Norwegian ships, viz:- "VESTVANGEN", "NORDVANGEN", "SORVANGEN", "DALVANGEN", "AUSTVANGEN" and "LINDVANGEN". It is understood that these are all sister ships, and are lying at your port.

In view of the fact that freeboards have not hitherto been assigned by Lloyd's Register to these ships, I have requested the Society's Surveyors at Oslo to forward such information as may be available for your guidance in holding the surveys.

In the meantime I enclose herewith photoprints of the approved profile and deck plans, midship section and First Entry Report on the steamer "DALVANGEN", for your guidance, and have to request that you will forward full particulars on Report Form C.11. for each ship.

You should attach a sketch to each report giving details and distribution of the deck sockets and eyeplates which are fitted for timber cargoes, and you should also give full
