F. I have to inform you that application forms, Req. 9 (N), for the assignment of International Convention freeboards have been received from Messrs. Gørrissen & Co., in respect of the following Norwegian ships, viz:- "NORDVANGEN", "SORVANGEN", "VESTVANGEN", "DALVANGEN", "AUSTVANGEN" and "LINDVANGEN", and in each case the survey is to be held at New Orleans, La., U.S.A.,

In view of the fact that freeboards have not been assigned by Lloyd's Register to these ships, I have to request that you will forward such information as may be available for the information and guidance of the Society's Surveyor.
