from an open to a closed shelter decker. The Freeboards

assigned by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping have

been marked on the vessel's sides, verified by the undersigned

and are as follows: This endorsement shall have no effect when the ship is:—

- Center of disc below top of steel shelter deck. . . . . 10' 8 1/4"
- Tropical fresh water line above center of disc. . . . . 13 1/2"
- Fresh water line above center of disc. . . . . 7"
- Tropical line above center of disc. . . . . 6 1/2"
- Winter line below center of disc. . . . . 6 1/2"

This Provisional Certificate is issued pending the issue of a Freeboard certificate by Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London,

but is in no case valid beyond the 30th June 1943.

(a) Area 1. The area within and to the north-west of the following line:—  
 A line drawn south from the east of Greenland at long. 58° W. to lat. 45° N., thence along the parallel of 45° N. to long. 15° W., thence north at lat. 60° N., thence along the parallel of 60° N. to the west coast of Norway, Bergen being considered as being on the boundary between this area and the area immediately to the south-west.

(b) Area 2. The area within of a line drawn from the east coast of America along the parallel of 36° N. to Tarifa in Spain excluding Area 1 above but including the Bahía de Cádiz.
