These two Ferro-Concrete Vessels both became due for Annual Survey in May 1923, and as they were reported to be laid up at Hangesund the Committee in May last deferred consideration for a time, subject to the vessels not being put into service without having the outstanding surveys held.

The Special Survey No. 1 is also due in both cases, and in reply to further inquiry the Bergen Surveyor now states that the vessels have been sold to Mr. H. Henriksen of Iceland and adds that they have left Hangesund for Iceland without being submitted to survey.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the cases before them on Tuesday, the 9th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessels' classes to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (9.24) in each case, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the new Owner has been informed accordingly.
