Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Ferro-Concrete Vessels "CRETECAMP" and "CRETEHIVE", which vessels it is understood have recently become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that the cases have been submitted to the Committee, together with a communication received from the Society's Surveyor at Bergen, from which it appears that the vessels have left Haugesund for Iceland without being submitted to the Special Annual Survey for which they are both considerably overdue.

The classes of these vessels have hitherto been allowed to remain undisturbed, subject to the necessary inspections taking place before they were again put into service, and in these circumstances the Committee regret that they have had no alternative but to expunge the vessels' classification from the Register Book with a red line in each case, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.


