With reference to the Greenock first entry report No.17612 on the Ferro-Concrete Dumb Barge "CRETEHIVE" (P.D.112) recently completed at that port by Messrs. The Scottish Concrete Ship Co., Ltd., I have to inform you that accounts have to-day been rendered to the Accountant General, Ministry of Shipping, for the fees due for the survey of this vessel during construction, and for the survey and assignment of freeboard, as under:-

For survey of Hull.....	£113: 5: 0
" " " Donkey Boiler and during installation on board.....	9: 9: 0
For survey and assignment of freeboard.....	2: 2: 0

Of the fee for the survey of the hull, £90:12:0 will be credited to your port, and the balance of £22:13:0 to the Greenock Office, together with the freeboard fee of £2:2:0, and one-third of the Donkey Boiler fee, viz:- £3:3:0. The balance of the Donkey Boiler fee, viz:- £6:6:0 will be due to this Office for the survey of the boiler during construction at the makers' works.

I enclose for your information a copy of a letter I have to-day addressed to the Greenock Surveyors respecting this case.

I may add that the Classification Certificate has been sent direct to the Ministry of Shipping.
