Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your motor vessel "RAPIDO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at Havana, from which it appears that no arrangements have been made by your goodselves for carrying out the Special Survey No.1, which became due in June last year, although he has communicated with you both by telephone and letter on the subject.

In the circumstances, and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey in question expired at the end of last month, the Committee regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary surveys and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee.
