With reference to the shafting of the Ferry Steamer "WYRESDALE" built by Messrs J. Robertson & Sons, Fleetwood, I beg to inform you that the boiler has been constructed for a working pressure of 170 lbs.

The plans of the shafting have been approved on a basis of 160 lbs working pressure and it is the intention of the Owners to operate the boiler at this pressure; the shafting, however, appears to be suitable for the designed pressure of the boiler, 170 lbs, and it is respectfully suggested that this pressure be recorded in the Register Book.
