Action was deferred from time to time in view of the vessel being laid up. She was recently sold to a Faroese firm and in view of a general examination of the hull, machinery and boilers at Goole in May last the Committee agreed to the vessel proceeding to the Faroe Islands, where it was intended to dismantle her for use as a factory.

In reply to enquiry the Thorshavn Surveyor now states the vessel is tied up alongside the quay in use as a store for fish oil, but is supplying steam for the factory, using one boiler in turn. The Owners can start cleaning for the Boiler Survey at once, but the ship cannot be docked there for screwshaft survey and the Surveyor asks for instructions.
