It is understood that this vessel has been sold to Mr. Gunnar Holm Jacobsen and I shall be glad if you will ascertain from him and let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the "Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys, which became due at the end of February last and September, 1949 respectively, to be carried out.

16th September 1950

Date: On receipt of this Memorandum I sent a letter to the Owner, Mr. G.H.Jacobsen, who told me: The vessel is tied up along side the quay at our fish-oil-plant used as store for fish-oil and supplying steam for the factory, using one of the boilers in turn. We can start Cleaning for boiler survey at once. The ship can not be docked here, so we can not carry out Screw Sahft Survey.
