

S.S. "TEMARA"

Mr. Dobbie telephoned from Hull stating that further discussions had taken place with Mr. Niel of Davies & Newman and in Mr. Dobbie's opinion the leakage could be stopped by temporary repairs which will enable him to issue an interim certificate for the voyage to Thorshavn via the Shetlands. The new Owners were arranging to send one of their trawlers to accompany the "TEMARA" on this voyage.

The purpose of Mr. Dobbie's telephone conversation was to draw attention to the fact that the screwshaft survey was overdue and to obtain authority to inform Mr. Niel who would be telephoning to Hull later this afternoon that provided the vessel's condition could be made satisfactory the desired interim certificate would be issued. Mr. Dobbie was informed that in these circumstances no objection would be taken to the issue of the certificate and that no difficulty would be placed in the way on account of the screwshaft survey.
