Further to mine enclosing blue print re the S.S. "SUNFLOWER" I am now enclosing you a letter received from the repairers Messrs. H. Parry & Son, of this city from which you will note the rudder has been increased 4 5/8" more than stipulated and you will note they state 18" wider than original and yet on the blue print sent you which was made by them it is clearly stated 18 5/8".

I have further to add that when I requested rudder to be increased 14" as stated on report N91519 after the work was finished I went over to the other side to verify rudder but same had already been shipped while the vessel was afloat with the assistance of a diver so that I was not able to verify dimensions and I never thought for a moment such a discrepancy would occur.
