Special Survey :- Vessel in dry dock, shell plating and rudder cleaned, examined and afterwards recoated. Inner bottom plating examined, bilges cleaned out and examined. The steelwork throughout exposed for examination and in view of its general condition was not required to be drilled. The double bottom tanks, deep tanks, cargo oil tanks, fuel oil tanks, cofferdams, forward and after peak tanks tested as required by the rules. All cargo oil tanks, fuel oil tanks, deep and double bottom tanks and cofferdams cleaned and examined internally. Pump rooms, machinery space, fore and aft spaces in way of fore and after peaks examined. Decks examined. The masts, rigging, anchors, chain cables and general equipment examined.
