Dear Sir,

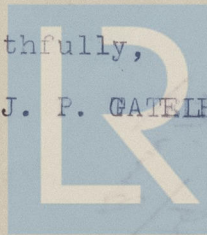
It was impossible to attend work in connection with a survey on the above named vessel's boiler.
