Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 8th August last and to your memorandum of the 10th September relative to the steamer "SAN PIETRO", I shall be glad if you will ascertain, and let me know, what arrangements are proposed to be made for the Special Survey No.2 to be completed, in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules expired at the end of last month, and as it appears from the Shipping Papers that the vessel left St. John, N.B. on the 30th ultimo for Naples.

I think it well to add that since my letter of the 8th August no part of the survey on the hull has been held, but the Boiler Survey was completed at Bremen in October last and the Committee have assigned the record BS 2,27 to the vessel. To complete the survey on the machinery the propeller, stern bush, sea connections and their fastenings, condenser, steam pipes, auxiliary engines and the arrangement of cocks, pipes, bilge suction, roses etc.
