Dear Sirs,

H. I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 2nd instant relative to the steamer "SAN PIETRO" and with regard thereto I may say that there is no record in this Office of any survey held recently on this vessel at Venice.

From the reports already received in this case it would appear that the steamer will be eligible for a record of LMC 2,27 when one tube in the port combustion chamber of the port boiler, and the main feed check valve of the centre boiler have been renewed; and the propeller, stern bush, sea connections, auxiliaries, pumping arrangements, condenser and steam pipe examined.

It would be well for you to ascertain from the Trieste Surveyors what action, if any, has been taken in this case at Venice.

As intimated in my letter of the 2nd June last, no part of the Special Survey No.2 has yet been held on the hull and the items referred to in the concluding paragraph of that letter are still outstanding.
