With reference to my letter of the 25th April last relative to the motorship "SIR CHARLES ORR", I have to acquaint you I am now in receipt of a letter from Lloyd's Agents at Nassau intimating that the Manager of this vessel is now in England, and that it is understood he proposes to have nothing done regarding the modified survey of the oil engines before he returns probably in August or September.

The case has again received the consideration of the Committee today, and in the circumstances they are agreeable to the inspection in question being carried out in August or September, subject to this arrangement being adhered to without fail, and I shall be glad if you will arrange accordingly.
