ACTION is DEFERRED for examination in dry dock after striking river bank and for repairs to rudder and steering gear.

The ROTTERDAM Surveyors report (5.49) the vessel examined in dry dock and, on account of damage, as above, permanent repairs/renewals effected to rudder head, steering gear and deck plate in way, etc.

Permanent repairs effected to shell plates (p & s).

Indented shell plates, as above, continued efficient and the Surveyor recommends repairs not later than the next Special Survey.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of docking 5.49, subject to indented shell plating, etc. (p & s) being examined at the next drydocking and dealt with as necessary by the next Special Survey.
