

condition.

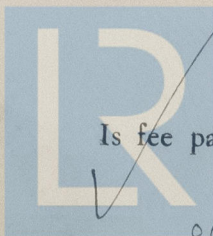
The Certificate in this case expires on the 30th June,
