With reference to the above entry in Rtn. 3 for the week ending 1st September, 1950, I have to inform you that this vessel is at present laid up at Durban.

The 2 main boilers were examined throughout, and evidence of chemical embrittlement was found in the combustion chambers of both boilers, there are 2 combustion chambers in each boiler. The Owners have been informed through their local agents, and tenders were called for the renewal of all combustion chambers. I understand that these tenders have been submitted to Amsterdam and that the local agents have been instructed to do nothing until they have received further instructions from Owners.
