
S. Your letter of the 10th instant, addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Naples, relative to your Steamer "CLIMPIA", has been forwarded to this Office, from which it is noted that, for economical reasons, you are abandoning the Classification of the vessel with this Society.

The Committee have had your letter before them at their meeting today and desire me to point out that the vessel's classification in the Society's Register Book has been continued up to the present on the understanding that the remaining requirements of the overdue Special Survey No.3 would be carried out on the vessel's arrival at Naples.

As you are aware, the Committee have granted an extension from time to time to meet your convenience with regard to the completion of the survey, and having regard to the fact that the year of grace expired in July, they regret that, in view of your decision, they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's Class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
