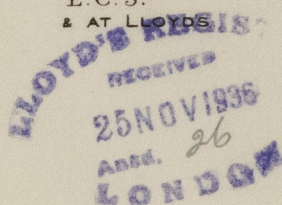

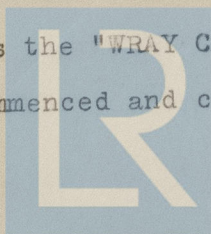

Dear Sir,

The Owner of the Italian steamer "OLIMPIA" ex
"WRAY CASTLE" is interested to set forth clearly the reasons
by which in the year 1925 the Committee of Lloyds Register
took the decision to consider this steamer as having been built
in 1920, and recorded this decision in Lloyds Book.

We understand that in 1925, the Owners of the
steamer, at that time Messrs. James Chambers & Co., brought
the matter before the Committee several times in order to
obtain the amendment of the date of construction in the
Register, from 1916 to 1920, and that the Committee finally
decided upon the production of further evidence of the vessel's
completion date to establish the date of construction
accordingly. We understand also that many other steamers
were in the same position as the "WRAY CASTLE", their
construction having been commenced and completion delayed as

We have consulted Messrs. Chambers in the matter and they are quite agreeable to your supplying us with copies of the various letters etc. in connection with this matter.


