H. Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th May last received today, and with regard to the concluding paragraph thereof concerning the steamer "RIO VERDE" I have to say that your later letter of the 16th May enclosing your Surveyor's report on this case duly came to hand and was not acknowledged in mine of the 7th instant.

It is observed from your letter under reply that the vessel was placed on a slipway for repairs, and it is concluded that a report was issued by your Surveyor on this matter in addition to the report on the Boiler Survey already furnished by your goodself. If this was the case it will be appreciated if you will kindly forward a report on the examination of the vessel's hull on the slipway and on any repairs which may have been carried out, in order that the case may receive the consideration of the Committee.
