the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

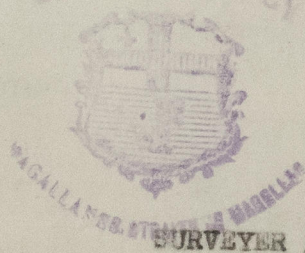
Mr. W. W. Watson, Lloyds Agent at this port, proceed on board the S.S.
"RIO VERDE" of 679 tons, of VALPARAISO, anchored in the Punta Arenas
Roads, for the purpose of surveying the Main Boiler, and Found :-

2nd. May. The Boiler thoroughly clean and free from scale,
the furnace crowns, shell plates, stays and rivets in good condition.
The three furnaces and plates of the combustion chambers, tube plates
and tubes, clean and in good condition. The manholes, boiler mountings
and boiler coatings in good condition.

3rd. May. A hydraulic test was made in my presence to a
pressure of 270 lbs. per square inch. No defects appeared.

5th. May. I examined the Main Boiler under the full working
steam pressure of 180 lbs. per square inch, at which the safety
valves are set.

I hereby recommend that the record be retained as in the register
book.
