I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant enclosing one from Mr. Dean, together with a plan of the engine and boiler casings in the bridge space of Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co's No.957 (S.S. "PEVERIL"), and with regard thereto I have to state that in view of the after end of the bridge being open it is considered that additional freeing facilities should be provided amidships, either by additional or larger scuppers, or by an additional freeing port each side, and I shall be glad if the surveyor will arrange accordingly.
