My dear Warlow,

In the case of the "CITÉ DE LÉVIS" (Glasgow No. 50653), it would appear that with a NHP of 277 the total First Entry fees should be £66-11-0. It is observed that a fee of £27-6-0 has been charged for the survey of the boiler (H.S.4438) and £38-6-0 for the machinery (three-fifths of the survey fee), which two amounts total: £65-12-0, or 19/- less than the Rule fee.

I draw your attention to this matter in case you would like to have an amended account sent to the Builders, but of course you must be <sup>the</sup> best judge as to whether this is desirable.
