I have to add that the approved boiler plan does not appear to have been forwarded with your Report, and I have to request that you will send on the same.

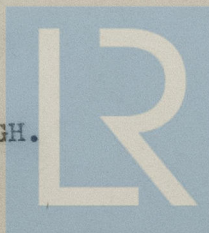
