Overhaul and additions are being carried out to the Engine by Messrs Wilson Copley & Co. Teesbank Engineering Works. North Street Middlesbrough, and that firm will fit the Machinery onboard. They are in touch with your office at Middlesbrough.

The Boiler has not yet been finally decided upon, it may be a boiler nearly completed at Meesrs Riley Bros works at Stockton building and completing under your Survey, or it may be a boiler in Aberdeen. In any case, it is our intention to have your Survey upon the Machinery and Boiler for this vessel.
