I have to acquaint you that this vessel was recently sold to the Indian Government and it was agreed that the overdue Special Survey could be postponed until her arrival at Bombay following a satisfactory examination at Alexandria. The Load Line Certificate was extended until the 23rd instant.

It is observed from the shipping ^{papers} that the vessel arrived at your Port on the 15th ultimo, and it is concluded she has now come under survey. I shall be glad, however, if you will advise me of the position.
