REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Emergency Docking.

This vessel sailed from Curacao, N.W.I. in loaded condition and on 5th June 1947 leakage was observed in shell plate 'F.3' (S.S) in way of the evaporator blow down cock. A cement box was fitted but as this could not be made tight the vessel returned to Curacao for repairs.
 Work Done:— Vessel placed in drydock, bottom, sides and rudder cleaned, examined and recoated.
 Found:— Shell plate F.3 (s.s) wasted through 60% of the way round the evaporator blow down cock and also longitudinally immediately above longitudinal shell frame 1st below blow down cock. Two fractures in shell plate J.3 (s.s) in way of shell clip to deep transverse in engine room. A fracture in shell plate 'E.8' (s.s) in way of batt with 'E.9'. A fracture approximately 12" long in 'F.2' (s.s) from forward in way of fore peak tank and a fracture in shell plate 'E.8' (P.S) in way of end of bilge keel shell angle. Rudder bearing hard on gudgeons and lifted.


