Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

in deck. An extension has been built on to aft end of gunners' house on the upper

This extension is of steel and strongly constructed.

Two lavatories and an access to the tween decks have been fitted in this new house.

The lavatories discharge below the freeboard deck and are fitted with storm valves.

The door giving access to the tween decks is of steel. Opening 4'9" x 22", Sill 19½".

A vent coaming has been fitted to upper deck to serve as an emergency escape. Coaming 30" dia. x 36" high x 38" thick. A wood plug and canvas cover is provided.
