I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, intimating that the s.s. "BOMBARDIER" has now been sold to Italian buyers, and is being dealt with by the Board of Trade for Load Line.

It is concluded in these circumstances that it is not your intention to submit the vessel to the Second Special Survey No.3 before she leaves, and the case will therefore come under the consideration of the Committee at their meeting tomorrow with a view to the vessel's class being dealt with.

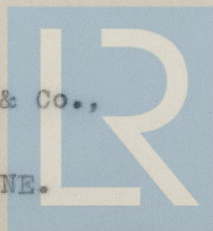
At the same time your request that the Midship Section plan of this vessel should be forwarded to the Chief Surveyor, Board of Trade, for perusal will also be dealt with.
