The above mentioned steamer has been sold to Italian Buyers and is being classed by the Board of Trade for Load Line.

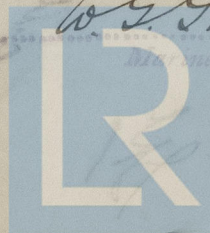
