S.S. "BOMBARDIER".

This "Kil" class vessel was built by Messrs. Smith's Dock Co., Ltd., under the survey of the British Corporation in 1918, to plans mutually approved by Lloyd's Register and the British Corporation, and classed A1 "For Government Service".

The vessel came under survey at Sunderland from April to August, 1920, when considerable alterations were made to render her suitable for carrying cargo, and she was classed by the Committee 100A1.

The question was recently raised as to when the Special Survey No.1 should be reckoned to become due, and the Surveyors were asked to state whether in their opinion the survey held when the vessel was converted for cargo carrying purposes could be considered as complying with the S.S.No.3.


Mr. Wray who held the survey stated in reply that in his opinion the survey might be considered as a Special Survey No.3.


The Newcastle Surveyors were accordingly requested to ascertain from the Owners whether they were agreeable to the Committee assigning a notation of S.S.No.3-8,20.

The Surveyors have now forwarded a letter from the Owners <sup>Representatives</sup> in which they state that when the survey was held, the arrangement was that the Special Surveys Nos.1, 2 & 3 would become due 4, 8 & 12 years respectively from the date of the conversion.

In order however that this might be the case it will be necessary for a notation of S.S.No.3 to be assigned.

It is therefore submitted that a notation of S.S. Sld.No.3-8,20 should be made against the vessel's name in the Register Book.
