Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 13<sup>th</sup> inst. respecting the tug "Garryowen II" I have to say that since I wrote on the 17<sup>th</sup> ult. the train and charabanc service to Limerick has been entirely discontinued until last week when it was again resumed. If the present service is maintained and travelling thereby appears to be reliable and safe I will arrange with the Owners of the Vessel to examine the cylinders at an early date.

I may say that it is possible to travel by sea to and from Limerick but, as nearly six days would be occupied from the time of leaving to the time of returning, I have considered it unadvisable to go that way for so small a survey.
