Dear Sir,

With further reference to your letter of the 25th ulto. relative to the tug "Garryowen II" I have to say that I wrote to the Owners of the vessel on the 9th inst. to arrange an early date for the examination of the IP and LP cylinders but a reply has not yet been received also, as the motor charabanc service between Cork and Buttevant has had to be suspended, it is again not possible to go to Limerick by that route. In view of these circumstances I propose to let the matter stand over until there are reasonable facilities for travelling and it is possible to communicate with the Owners through the Post Office without so much delay.

I will advise you as soon as it is possible to make arrangements for holding the required survey.
