Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 17th inst. relative to the
tamer "Garryowen II" I have to say that your letter of the
18th ulto. came to hand on the 7th inst. and I wrote to the
owners of the Vessel the same day. A reply has not yet
been received and it seems likely that my letter has
not yet been delivered or that, if the Owners have received
it, they are not able to make any arrangements
to present for me to examine the cylinders.

Railway trains have not been running
between Cork and Limerick direct for some time past
and telegraphic and telephonic communication
has been very uncertain. I will let you know as
soon as arrangements have been made by Messrs
Cannatyne & Sons, Ltd. and, if necessary, I will commu-
cate with them again by letter.
